Coaches Jim Dietz and Mark Wilson will be hosting the 2024 HOOCR Sculling Camp. There is no bigger or more spectacular race than the Head Of The Charles®. The bridges, the basin, the turns, the excitement, the history, the boathouses and the crowds make the Head of the Charles a must for every rowing enthusiast. Mark and Jim have been presenting this camp for over 13 years and each year we hear how informative and important it is, we thank you for coming and hope that 2024 will be a huge success as well! If you are racing or not, this camp is a great experience in a great location, and everyone will leave with newfound sculling confidence!

2024 Camp will be run from the Boston Latin School dock which is adjacent to Northeastern University's Henderson Boathouse. This location is just past the finish line and so we will look at each section of the river through the three days on the water. We will provide light lunch foods and fruit for between rowing sessions. A fun evening of optional eating in town will also be included as well as great stories and fun off the water.

Jim is a true legend on the Charles and we both will cover the course as well as boat/oar rigging, circuit training for rowing, nutrition, and plenty of more topics to get you up to speed. Special video analysis using the overhead views from the bridges and from the launch will help you learn the course!

- Camp is Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday with three great days on the Charles
- Rowing in singles and doubles will be stressed, Please bring your own if possible (rentals **may** be available for additional fee. There is no guarantee for a rental but we will help when possible.
- Head of the Charles racing technique by Jim Dietz and Mark Wilson
- 6 on-the-water rowing sessions!! Eat, Sleep, Row, Repeat
- Light refreshments between rows will be provided and campers are welcome to add to the mix!
- Video review of each rowing session, video clips will be placed online
- Shore sessions include: Training methodology, Drills, Boat/Oar Rigging, and Strategy specific to the master's athlete, racing technique specific for the Charles
- Complete written stroke analysis and critique to take home.

This Camp will be a very special event and will be limited to 14 scullers. Coach to rower ratio is kept at 1-7 or better to maintain personal and meaningful coaching. Your time is valuable, and we strive to give you all the attention you deserve and more.
